Driving Efficiency and Compliance: Texas Facilities Commission's HUB Subcontracting Evolution



In line with its commitment to citizen welfare and promoting diversity in subcontracting opportunities, the State of Texas requires vendors to complete a HUB Subcontracting Plan (HSP) for each solicitation that would lead to a contract exceeding \$100,000 in value. This requirement reflects the state's commitment to document and promote the involvement of HUBs in its procurement processes. To comply, agencies must develop a comprehensive plan demonstrating genuine effort. They must document their utilization of HUBs via specific, outlined methods, submit the completed HSP with bids/proposals, and maintain all documentation, including Progress Assessment Reports (PAR).

The goal-oriented Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) team at Texas Facilities Commission (TFC), driven by a commitment to meet these standards, embarked on a comprehensive review of their processes. This assessment uncovered several obstacles impacting the accuracy of their work and the organization's overall efficiency. Consequently, the efficiency-focused HUB team diligently sought solutions to overcome these challenges, which included excessive paperwork and communication tracking difficulties arising from the receipt of HSPs via hard copies or email. Manual review processes proved error-prone, particularly in verifying percentages and calculations. Additionally, complexities arose in validating HUB certifications, confirming scopes, and assessing subcontractor awards. Converting hard copy HSPs into electronic formats for storage frequently led to challenges in validating scopes and selected subcontractors due to the absence of necessary supporting documents for compliance verification.

The Solution

Since 2016, TFC has effectively utilized the B2Gnow system to manage, track, and report on its HUB program compliance. While the contract compliance module played a crucial role in overseeing payments to certified vendors, TFC sought an integrated solution to fulfill the complex requirements of HSPs.
